#### **ASSEMBLY**

The Northwest City Council held their regular meeting on Tuesday, February 26, 2019 at 7:00 PM, at Northwest City Hall, 4889 Vernon Road.

#### **CALL TO ORDER & INVOCATION**

Mayor Knox called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Councilman Haywood Miller gave the invocation.

#### **CONSENT AGENDA**

Councilman Charles Carroll **MOVED**, **SECONDED** by Councilman Haywood Miller to approve the Consent Agenda as presented. The **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY**.

#### **DISCUSSION & ACTION ITEMS**

#### A. BARKLEY LANE

She also stated that the Water Shortage Response Plan is intended to provide a framework of steps and activities to be implemented as conditions require.
