# • WHO DECLARES A STATE OF EMERGENCY?

The Mayor declares a state of emergency but in his absence the Mayor Pro Tem will declare the emergency.

# • EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER (EOC) IS ESTABLISED WHEN? WHERE?

The emergency operations center should be activated whenever there is a major incident that causes significant property damage, potential or actual business disruption or has the potential to cause a significant impact on business.

The EOC will be established at City Hall. If needed, the Emergency Coordinator may work with a local Church to set up operations.

# o TORNADO

City Hall's designated place is in the hallway by the kitchen sink.

Councilman Haywood Miller MOVED, SECONDED by Councilwoman Sheila Grady to purchase a weather radio to be kept in the Administration Office. The MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

If a fire is in City Hall, employees will need to evacuate and go to the City of Northwest Park Concession Building.

# EARTHQUAKE

Employees at City Hall will need to get under desk and cover their head.

# SEARCH AND RESCUE

If needed, City Hall will become the EOC.

# SCHEDULE OF EQUIPMENT RATES
